



MOUNT COMPASS OPEN 2020 (Peter Crafter Memorial Trophy)

(To be played over 18 holes)

Conditions of Competition

1. Open to male and female amateurs who hold a Golf Australia handicap. Junior nominees must be under 18 years of age on the day of event.
2. The event will be Stroke (off the stick) for A Grade and Stableford for Men's B and C grade and Women. Players may only compete under one category as recorded on their entry form.
3. The entry fee must be paid at the time of submission of entry form, otherwise the nomination may not be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone without coinciding payment by credit card.
4. The Mount Compass Golf Course also reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving an explanation. Any entrant may withdraw and have their entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the date entries close.
5. The field for this event will be limited to 72 players in total. In the event of entries exceeding this limit a handicap ballot will apply. Late entries may be accepted if numbers permit.
6. Competitors must start at the appointed time. R & A Rule 5.3 will apply.
7. The Match committee of the Mount Compass Golf Club will determine playing arrangements and act as umpire in the case of a dispute or protest, which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the clubhouse no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.

In the event of a tie in the Stroke event a play-off will determine a winner. In the Stableford event a count-back will apply to determine a winner.
8. Pace of Play. Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be applied to players in such groups who, by their pace, contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to implementation of penalties.
9. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
10. The use of motorized buggies is permitted.
11. Players and Caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of the Mount Compass Golf Course.
12. EXTREME WEATHER POLICY: In the interest of player safety, it is recommended that players exercise caution during extreme weather conditions.
13. Prizes will be awarded for best gross and best nett scores in each grade. A player may only win one major prize.
